

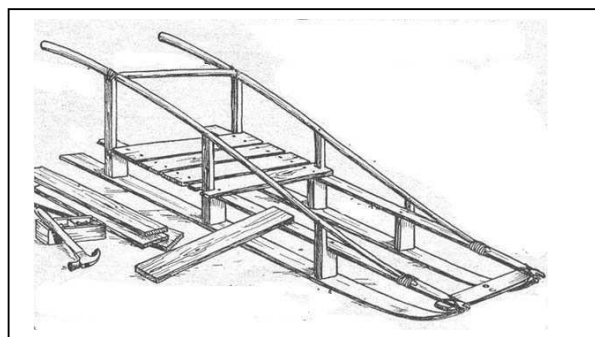

2009 KLONDIKE DERBY EVENTS

THE FROZEN GLACIER: Your team has discovered gold in a mountain glacier. To register your claim you must melt the glacier and free the nuggets from its icy grip. All of the nuggets you free from the ice in 10 minutes will be yours to keep.

RING THE BELL: Better yet, DON'T!! Lash a pyramid with your poles and ropes. Guide it over, under, and through the obstacles.

GET READY FOR SOME CURLING (and I don't mean your hair): Build up some speed and charge for the target. See how many times your patrol can hit the bull's eye. It sure sounds easy,,,,,,,,,

Klondike Biathlon: Each team races to a target. The team will throw three snowballs at each of three targets (a total of nine attempts). Bring your Scout with the best aim. Oh, did we mention that you will all be on a set of Swish Skis throughout the entire event? Guess you better bring your teamwork, too!

FLING THAT THING: Can you drop a snowball on a target? Test your teamwork and aim and try it from 100 yards away. Oh, I forgot to mention, you will be blindfolded and taking directions from your patrol leader.

I'M A LUMBERJACK AND I'M OK: Use teamwork to saw the log. The more, the better!! Practice your aim and skills with a hatchet. Think you can split a match?

Each sled must bring all of the equipment they deem necessary to compete in these events. Some items are specific to an event and will be supplied.
